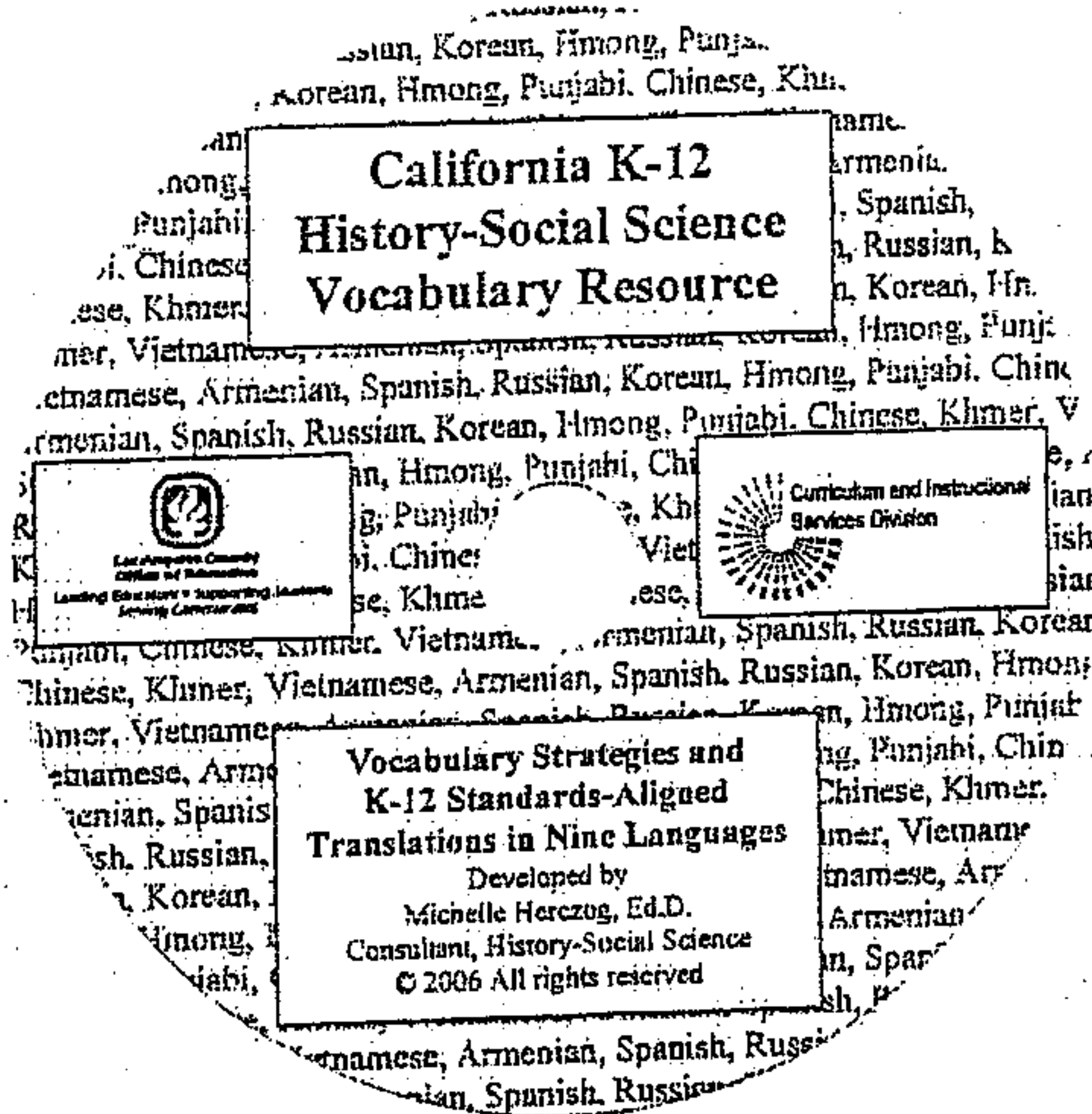

In September 2004, the State Board of Education adopted amendments to Title 5 regulations for the Standardized Testing and Reporting (STAR) program. Section 853.5 of the California Education Code, titled "Use of Variations, Accommodations and Modifications," specifies that school districts shall provide identified English Learner pupils testing variations, if regularly used in the classroom or for assessment. One acceptable test variation is to provide translation glossaries/word lists for the Standards Based Achievement Tests. As support material, this CD can be used as part of instruction and assessment.
