
# Residential Construction

# Construction Laborer

Average Salary: \$37,890
Perform tasks involving
physical labor at construction
sites. May operate hand and
power tools of all types: air
hammers, earth tampers,
cement mixers, small
mechanical hoists, surveying
and measuring equipment, and
a variety of other equipment
and instruments.

#### Carpenter

Average Salary: \$55,920
Construct, erect, install, or repair structures and fixtures made of wood and comparable materials, such as concrete forms; building frameworks, including partitions, joists, studding, and rafters; and wood stairways, window and door frames, and hardwood floors.

# Structural Iron and Steel Workers

Average Salary: \$54,830
Raise, place, and unite iron or steel girders, columns, and other structural members to form completed structures or structural frameworks. May erect metal storage tanks and assemble prefabricated metal buildings.
