- 4. Care for the physical, social-emotional, and overall well-being of our Vikings.




#### **Coach/Volunteer Clearance**



Athletes can make up absences (10+ absences will make them ineligible), while working with their team. Requires 4 consecutive hours of activity on campus. Allows for creativity in designing sessions to do things like:

## What do we expect from our athletes? Follow the protocols

## #1 GET CLEARED! Student Athlete Clearance

Students must be fully cleared to try-out, practice, dress for games, transport, & be on sidelines. Only parent email accounts will be accepted.

- Complete an Athletic Packet every academic year: <u>July 1st</u> -<u>June 30th</u>
  - sports physical, insurance, code of conduct, student & parent signatures.



#### ATHLETIC CLEARANCE PACKET

MV Vikings: if you are planning to play a sport, join band, cheer, drill or color guard you will need to complete an Athletic Clearance Packet online.

#### CLICK HERE TO COMPLETE THE ATHLETIC CLEARANCE PACKET

Steps for parents to complete the online packet:

- Parents will CREATE AN ACCOUNT (please do not use student email
- Click on START CLEARANCE HERE
- FOR SCHOOL: Type in Mountain View and select Mountain View. Make sure the address shows 2900 Parkway Drive, El Monte, CA
- Select the 2024-2025 school year
- Select <u>all the sports</u> your child will participate in (use ADD NEW SPORT to add a new sport)
- Then click NEXT
- · You will then go through the different sections to fill out
  - Student
  - Parent/Guardian
  - Medical
  - Additional Questions
- Signatures (This section requires both the Student & Parent signature)
- . UNDER FILES, you will upload a copy of:
  - Physical Form (MEDICAL ELIGIBILITY FORM)
  - Your child's medical card.
- Once you have finished all sections you will click SUBMIT COMPLETED APPLICATION
- You will be given a confirmation message, this does not mean the student is cleared.
- You will receive a separate notification that your child has been APPROVED.

The El Monte Union High School District requires a yearly physical for students participating in co-curricular and extracurricular activities. All physicals will expire 1 year from the initial date of physical. Physical Expiration emails will be sent to the email on file at 30 days, and again at 10 days. Once submitted and approved, your physical will be valid for 1 calendar year from your initial physical date. EMDHSD and CIF-SS require all sports physical exams to be completed by a qualified medical provider. Qualified exams, signatures and documentation are acceptable from the following: Medical Doctor, Doctor of Osteopathic, Nurse Practitioner, or Physician's Assistant, (MD, DO, NP, PA).

### **#2 Be Healthy**

**Yearly Sports Physical** - ideally in June, July, or August to cover all seasons from July 1 - June 30th.

**Emergencies** - Should an injury occur that requires the athlete to be removed from the playing or practice field:

- Ocaches/trainers will provide first aid or in an emergency, call 911
- Call parents/guardians using Emergency Card
- Parents should take student to be immediately evaluated by a doctor
- Report results to school nurse:

Clearance to Resume - If an athlete requires medical attention or misses practice on the request of a physician, the athlete must have a written note of clearance from physician before returning to practice. Students must submit a copy of clearance to the Health Office and the Activities Office.



### **#3 Live by the Code of Conduct**

Your actions and behavior as a member of an El Monte Union High School District (EMUHSD) athletic team reflect not only upon yourself and your family, but also upon your team and your school. Every EMUHSD athlete should pursue the 6 pillars of character:

- TRUSTWORTHINESS be honest
- **RESPECT** treat others with respect
- RESPONSIBILITY do what you're supposed to
- **FAIRNESS** play by the rules
- CARING be kind & compassionate
- CITIZENSHIP make your community better



Participation is a PRIVILEGE, not a right. Be a role model representing the best of Mountain View

### #4 Stay Academically Eligible

State of California requires all athletes:

- Must have a 2.0 GPA at the end of the previous grading period & passing at least 4 classes.
  - Incoming 9th graders enter eligible to play in a Fall sport
- Make successful progress toward meeting graduation requirements.
- Any student who earns more than one
   "4" in Citizenship is put on probation for
   2 weeks (can't play in games)
- Eligibility or ineligibility takes effect the first Friday after the grading period ends.
- Student transfers require transfer paperwork to be approved by CIF.


### **#5 Take care of your uniforms**

- All uniforms are checked out to students and must be returned by students. Athletes are financially responsible for all equipment and uniforms they checked out.
- Team uniforms are to be worn only by athletes on game days.
- Uniforms must be turned in within 1 week of the season ending
- Athletes may not try out for another sport until all equipment has been returned.



### #6 Stay Committed - Attend practices

- Practices are mandatory and can be held daily (except for Sunday)
- Attendance is taken, especially for those getting Athletics credit
- Athletes need to communicate with their coaches ahead of time if they need to miss practice. Employment is not a valid excuse for missing.
- Practice schedules can be found on our <u>MVHS Website Calendar</u>
- An athlete wanting to quit must get approval from the coach and athletic director or they will not be allowed to participate in another sport until the following season.



#### **#7** Be here on time every day

- Students with 10+ absences will become ineligible for athletics
- Students who are truant 2 or more periods in a single week, cannot play in the next game the following week.
- On game days, students must attend 3 periods of school in order to play in the game.
- Students who are chronically late or out of class will also lose the opportunity to participate.



### **#8 Behave Appropriately**

A student athlete may not use any illegal substance including vaping, consuming alcohol, narcotics or performance enhancing drugs.

- 1st Violation: lose eligibility for the next
   2 consecutive events or 2 weeks
   (whichever is greater).
- 2nd Violation: lose eligibility for next 6 events
- 3rd or more violations: lose eligibility for next 12 events, and require a treatment program in order to be reinstated any sooner.





## **#8 Behave Appropriately**

Avoid any suspendable offenses including:

- **Fights**
- Possession, furnishing a weapon
- Robbery, stealing
- Causing damage to school or private property
- Committing an obscene act or engaging in habitual profanity or vulgarity.
- Arranging, offering, or negotiating to sell any drug paraphernalia

A student athlete will be suspended from all athletics for the remainder of the semester, or for six weeks, whichever is longer.


#### How varsity football's last game went from touchdowns to throwdowns

## Follow the EMUHSD Spectator Policy

#### **Unacceptable Behavior**

The following represent some, but not all examples of negative spectator behavior, and will not be tolerated.

- Disrespectful or derogatory yells, chants, or gestures directed at the opposing team
- Booing or heckling an official's decision, criticizing officials, displays of temper
- Engaging an opposing fan or group of fans in a dispute or argument
- Yells that antagonize opponents or their fans
- Blaming the loss of a game on officials, coaches or participants
- Yelling at or criticizing coaches or student participants of either team
- Destruction of property, signs, or equipment
- Running onto the floor or field of play before, during or after the contest
- Use of profane, vulgar or abusive language or name calling

## **Consequences for violating Spectator Policy**

Any person acting in an unacceptable manner faces ejection from the contest or activity and possible exclusion from subsequent contests or activities.

**1st Offense:** verbal warning to spectator by administrator for misconduct. Principal shall have the right to eject the spectator from event at first offense if offense is considered to be of serious nature and this action shall be treated the same as second offense.

**2nd Offense:** Immediate ejection. Letter of warning will be issued by Principal

**3rd Offense:** A ban from attending all future events for the entire school year. A follow up letter from the District.


## Trust!
