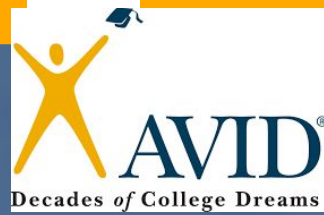

High School AVID

The high school AVID program is ideally a four-year program for students who have the potential to succeed in college prep courses. Such students demonstrate a desire to attend college. Upon acceptance into AVID, students must also enroll in college prep courses which will result in fulfilling entry requirements for most stateside colleges and universities. AVID is an elective class which meets during the regular school day.

Advancement Via Individual Determination (AVID) Mission Statement

The mission of AVID is to ensure that all students, especially middle-performing students, will:

- succeed in the most rigorous curriculum;
- enter the mainstream activities of the school;
- increase their enrollment in four-year colleges, and
- become educated, responsible participants and leaders in a democratic society.

EARLY COLLEGE ACADEMY

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Early College Academy at South El Monte High School is a unique four-year program that enables students to earn college credits while completing their high school diploma.

HOW IT WORKS

- Students take a Rio Hondo College course each semester, completing at least 6 units per year.
- Successful participation across all four years results in earning **24 college credits** and **40 high school credits**.
- Courses are taught on the South El Monte High School campus during the school day by college professors.
- Upon high school graduation, students can:
 - Continue their education at Rio Hondo College with free one-year tuition and priority registration
 - Transfer to a four-year college or university.

The Early College Academy is designed to prepare students for success in **college, career, and civic life**.



ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Current 8th-grade student.
- Enrolled or planning to enroll as a 9th-grade student at South El Monte High School.
- **Preferred GPA:** Minimum 2.5.
- **Recommended Grades:** B- or higher in Math and English.
- **Recommended SBAC Score:** 3 ("Met Standard") in ELA and Math.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Students must pass all courses in the Early College Academy program with a grade of C or better to remain in the program and to earn the stole and plaque at the end of their senior year.
- Courses are predetermined, and students are expected to adhere to the established schedule.
- Counselors may recommend exiting the program if students fail to follow Rio Hondo's academic guidelines, South El Monte High School policies, or if they are not making academic progress or have attendance/behavior issues.

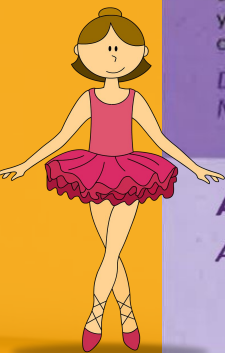

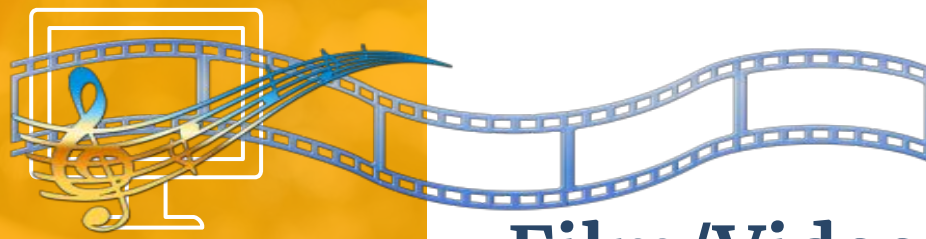
