Summer School

- Incoming freshmen students can enroll up to 1 summer class. Students will be placed in the appropriate class based on 8th grade teacher recommendation.
- Summer School class offerings are the following:

 - Math Readiness IM1 recommended for Fall
 - ELD Workshop High School English elective
 - Summer Bridge Organizational skills, study habits and educational activities
 - RHC Math Academy Finish a math level during the summer

- Last day of Summer School is Friday, July 18, 2025

Fall Registration

- By appointment in August.
- All 9th grade students must take 7 classes. Freshmen must enroll in English, Math, Science, PE 9, Health/Ethnic Studies. The core classes will be assigned based upon middle school recommendation.
- All 9th grade students will be registered for PE 9. Students who will participate in Athletics or in Drill/Cheer will be moved to ATHLETICS in the fall after receiving the fall sports rosters, if the schedule permits.
