Title I, Part A

Title I, Part A is a federally funded program authorized under the new education law, Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). Title I funds are provided to high poverty schools to help improve instruction and ensure all students meet state academic standards. The school-wide Title I program allows the school to use these funds to engage in reform strategies that increase the amount and quality of learning and help provide high-quality curriculum for all students. As directed by the California Department of Education (CDE), the school focuses it's use of Title I funds on students, including English learners and students with disabilities, who are not meeting proficiency on the state standards.

Title III (English Language Acquisition)

Title III, Part A is a federally funded program authorized under the new education law, Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). Title III funds are provided to is to ensure that all limited English proficient (LEP) students, or English learners, attain English proficiency, develop high levels of academic attainment in English, and meet the same challenging state academic standards as all other students. Title III LEP funds must be used for the following supplementary services as part of the language instruction program for LEP students:

- English language development instruction
- Enhanced instruction in the core academic subjects
- High-quality professional development for teachers and other staff members

Migrant Education

Students qualify for this district-wide supplemental program if they have changed residencies within the past three years to allow a member of the immediate family to secure seasonal or temporary employment in agriculture, the fishing industry, or related food processing. The funds are used to provide tutoring in subjects that meet graduation requirements. The program may provide teachers, instructional aides, tutors, and counselors to assist these students. Annual dental and health check-up services are also provided.
