What is it?

Operational Support persons provide an environment and support systems for the delivery of health care. Careers could include biomedical engineering, epidemiology, social worker, biomedical technician and others.

Occupational Therapist

Average Salary: \$96,640

Assess, plan, organize, and participate in rehabilitative programs that help build or restore daily living skills, as well as general independence, to persons with disabilities.



Sports and Physical Therapist

Average Salary: \$96,640

Assess, plan, organize, and participate in rehabilitative programs that improve mobility, relieve pain, increase strength, and improve or correct disabling conditions resulting from disease or injury.



Licensed Practical Nurses

Average Salary: \$52,840

Care for ill, injured, or convalescing patients or persons with disabilities in hospitals, nursing homes, clinics, private homes, group homes, and similar institutions. May work under the supervision of a registered nurse. Licensing required.

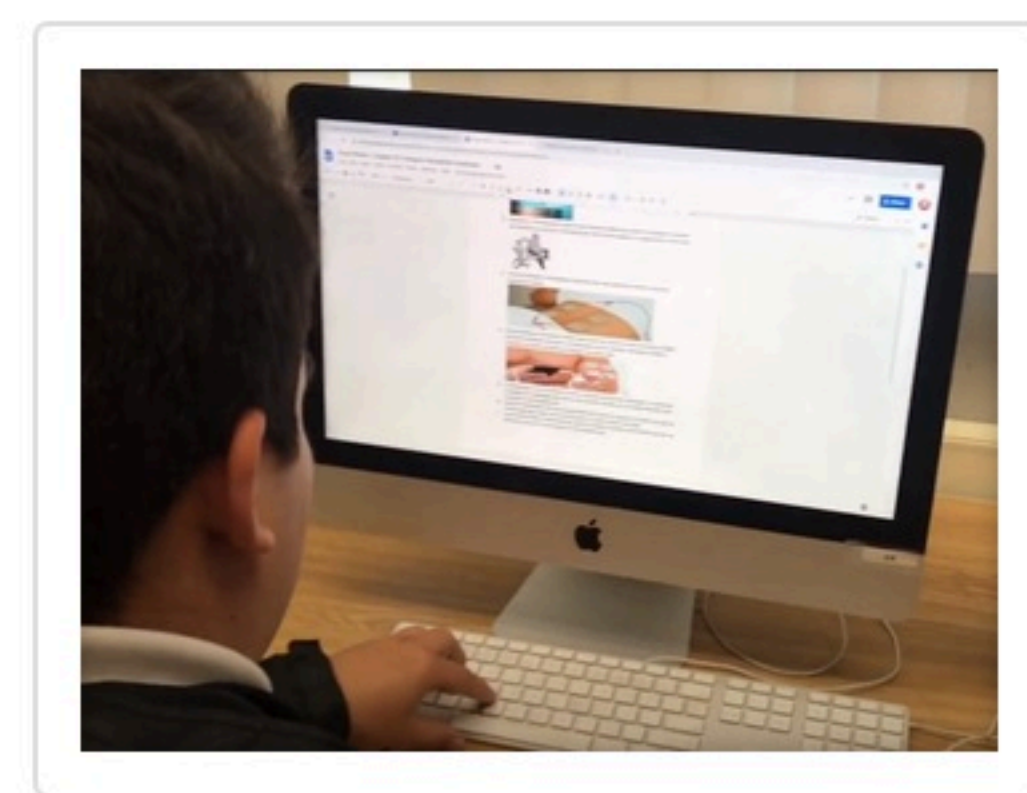
