## ROSEMEAD HIGH SCHOOL Honors, Advanced Placement and Accelerated Courses Parent/Student Agreement 2021-2022

*Instruction*: Read the agreement, complete the bottom of this form and submit it to your counselor on your scheduled registration date. Enrollment in an Honors/AP/Acc course will NOT be allowed without the submission of this form. It is **strongly recommended** that the student(s) and the parent(s) attend the AP Night.

## All students and parents of those students who wish to register for an Honors (Hnrs), Advanced Placement (AP) or Accelerated (Acc) course must sign the following agreement. Signatures affirm that:

- 1. Parent and student agree that the student meets the prerequisites and has the skills and tenacity for the class(es) indicated below. Participating in Honors/AP/Acc classes requires the student to:
  - a. Demonstrate increased independence.
  - b. Take on a high degree of responsibility.
  - c. Meet higher standards than students in non-Honors/AP/Acc courses to earn the same grade.
  - d. Spend as much as 1 ½ 2 hours of homework each night per class. \*Please take this into consideration when enrolling in multiple AP classes.
  - e. Commit to completing any required summer work on time and in a satisfactory manner.
  - f. Commit to remain enrolled in the class(es) for the entire school year.
  - g. Take the AP Exam for the corresponding course in May. A student who fails to take the corresponding AP exam will lose AP credit and the class title will change to Non-AP. Currently, all AP exams are paid for by EMUHSD.
  - h. Uphold the school's academic integrity policy. A student may be dropped from the class(es) if cheating, plagiarism, or work not personally completed by the student is submitted. \*Other consequences may occur depending on circumstance.
- 2. While transfers to a non-Honors/AP/Acc class may be granted, the following policy will apply:
  - a. Parent/student may request a transfer within the first twenty calendar days of the fall semester.
  - b. Teachers may request a student be transferred within the first twenty days of the fall semester if the student does not display behavior consistent with the behaviors outlined in 1.a -1.h above.
  - c. All transfer requests will result in a parent/student/teacher/counselor conference. **Permission to transfer** will be granted only if space is available.
  - d. Grades earned in the Honors/AP/Acc class(es) will be transferred to the non-Honors/AP/Acc class(es), when appropriate.
