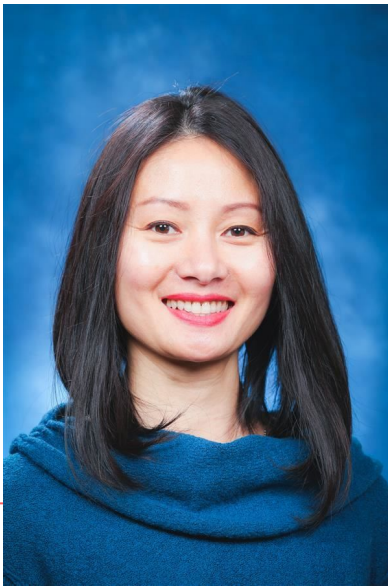

All Work will Reflect on Transcripts

- 220 credits
- 10 cr. per course per year / 5 cr. per semester
- “D” grades are not recognized by 4 year universities
- “F” grades do not receive any credits
- Classes failed must be repeated
- “D’s” may have to be repeated to move forward
- Grades become part of the permanent record

EMUHSD Graduation Requirements

- Social Science 3 years, 30 credits
 - English 4 years, 40 credits
 - Mathematics 2 years, 20 credits
 - Science (Life & Physical) 2 years, 20 credits
 - Fine Arts/Foreign Lang/
CTE 1 year, 10 credits
 - Physical Education 2 years, 20 credits
 - Health 1 semester, 5 credits
 - Electives 75 credits
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- Total Grad Requirements 4 years, 220 credits



A-G University Entrance Requirements

- A: Social Science 2 years, (3 years)
 - B: English 4 years
 - C: Mathematics 3 years, (3-4 years)
 - D: Science 2 years, (3-4 years)
(*Life & Physical*)
 - E: Foreign Language 2 years, (3-4 years)
 - F: Visual/Performing Arts 1 year
 - G: College Prep Elective 1 year
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- **Total Minimum** 15 year long courses



Stay on the A-G Path

- You must earn a C or HIGHER in all high school classes
- Get help EARLY and OFTEN!
- Take math courses every year
- Community College is still COLLEGE, so prepare by taking A-G coursework!

Freshman Classes

- **English:** English 1P or English 1P ACC
- **Math:** Integrated Math 1P or 2P

- **Physical Education:** PE9 or PE9 (Athletics)
- **Elective:** Health, Pathway, or Support Course

Dual Enrollment Program

- **Partnership with Rio Hondo College** - provides student the opportunity to *earn FREE college credits* while participating in a CTE pathway *while earning high school credit*.
- Courses taken at RHS
- Credits transferable to UC's or CSU's
- Motivated students with minimum 2.5 GPA, earning B- or higher in Math and English courses, & IM2 eligible.
- **Cyber Careers Pathway** - Look at exploring the practice of protecting computer systems, networks, and software from attack, unauthorized access, theft or damage.

Biliteracy Seal

- RHS offers a biliteracy seal upon graduation
- This seal recognizes high school graduates who have attained a high level of proficiency in speaking, reading, and writing one or more languages in addition to English.
- Schools & employers are strongly emphasizing being biliterate

- Return all items to the Activities Office to review and process prior to first practice/tryout

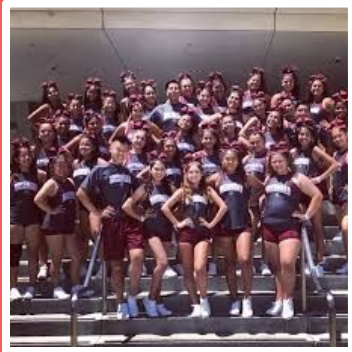
