- Partnership with Rio Hondo College provides student the opportunity to earn FREE college credits while participating in a CTE pathway while earning high school credit.

- Motivated students with minimum 2.5 GPA, earning B- or higher in Math and English courses, & IM2 eligible.
- **Cyber Careers Pathway** Look at exploring the practice of protecting computer systems, networks, and software from attack, unauthorized access, theft or damage.


