



COVID Screening Process

Fast Pass

Students who have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19 may present proof of vaccination to their school in order to receive a fast pass emblem on their student ID card. This Fast-Pass emblem will allow students to skip the daily screening and temperature taking needed to enter campus.

Qualifying students who are medically eligible are encouraged to present proof of COVID-19 vaccination to their school as soon as possible.

Students who presented proof of vaccination during the summer will not need to submit proof once again.

COVID-19 At-Home Screening

Students who do not receive the fast pass emblem on their student ID card will be required to complete a daily at-home COVID-19 screener. This screener will be available on student chromebooks. Once the screener is completed, it will email students a daily pass that will be used to enter campus. This daily pass must be presented upon entering campus. In order to expedite campus entry, students should complete the at home screener before leaving their home every morning. This option requires temperature taking which will occur randomly at predetermined time intervals.

COVID-19 In-Person Screening

Students who are not fully vaccinated, or who do not complete the daily COVID-19 at-home screener, or who lost a fast pass ID, or who cannot present a daily pass will be required to participate in COVID-19 in-person screening at the school gate. This option also requires temperature taking which will occur randomly at predetermined time intervals.

EMUHSD will continue to monitor guidance from the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health and will make adjustments as needed. We thank you for your cooperation and support and encourage all qualifying students to obtain a fast pass emblem as soon as possible. Please contact your local high school for additional information as needed.

Student Expectations

- Be on time daily, positive daily attendance promotes student success, Chronic absenteeism must be avoided.
- Student must wear face coverings on campus.
- All students are assigned a Chromebook, Chromebook and charger should be brought to school daily.
- Students should come prepared to school backpack, school supplies
- Dress code enforced
- All students must present a note, phone call for absences
- Check your school issued Google email daily
- Student Mental Health is a priority
- Students must have a school issued ID at all times


