The first two weeks (day class) and the first five weeks (evening class) include the theory and lab required before students may work with patients. Classes will begin **January 2022**. **Class time cannot be missed or made up.** Hours will be assigned for remaining weeks.

- A. You must be at least 18 years old to apply for Nursing Assistant class.
- B. Required health clearance includes a history and physical by an M.D. and a 2-step TB skin test or TB blood test; if the skin test is positive, a chest x-ray is needed. Flu Shot. Drug screening. Covid-19 vaccination card. **Due the first day of class.**
- C. Fingerprints will be taken via Live Scan; time will be announced in class.
- D. Criminal clearance for conviction of a crime other than a minor traffic ticket will be required to attend clinical.
- E. Clinical instruction will be scheduled. Clinical assignments will be given in class.
- F. CPR course is recommended prior to completion of NA course.
- G. Personal Health Insurance is highly recommended for each individual. El Monte-Rosemead Adult School will not be held liable for any injury incurred during class time.
- H. Must be fully vaccinated in order to register.

PLEASE BRING THE FOLLOWING **ORIGINAL** DOCUMENTS AND ITEMS TO THE NA ENTRANCE EXAM:

1. **Social Security Card**
2. **California Driver License or California I.D.**
3. **Covid-19 Vaccination Card (Must provide proof of vaccination to register)**

MUST BE ON TIME FOR ENTRANCE EXAM, LATE ARRIVALS WILL NOT BE ADMITTED.

NOTE: Due to clinical facility requirements, students with **prior criminal conviction(s)** are encouraged to be cleared by the Department of Justice prior to enrollment in the class. Information is available in Room 216.

Weekday, evening and weekend clinical hours may be required weeks 2 through 9 for Morning 10-week class.

Students are required on the **1st day of NA class** to bring the following **original** documents:

- 1) **Social Security Card;**
- 2) **California Driver License or California ID;**
- 3) **Physical Exam with TB Clearance;**
