



Vocational Nursing Program

Program Description

The Vocational Nursing (VN) program is a 13-month program to train students for an entry-level vocational nursing positions. It is a full-time commitment. Upon successful completion, students will be eligible to take the NCLEX-PN[®] examination.

The VN program is accredited by the Board of Vocational Nursing and Psychiatric Technicians (BVNPT).

Prerequisites

Medical Terminology and **Anatomy & Physiology** from the El Monte-Rosemead Adult School or from an accredited community college, must be within the last 5-years. Additionally, the **CPR (BLS-American Heart Association)** must not expire before the end of December 2020. These Three (3) pre-requisites must be completed before the VN application process starts on **Monday, July 22, 2019**.

Admission Qualifications

- Must be at least eighteen (18) years old.
- Provide proof of a high school diploma or GED certificate from an accredited school with official transcripts, or college degree with official transcripts from an accredited college, the three (3) pre-requisites, and two (2) non-relative reference letters.
- Pass the VN entrance examination.
- Complete a scheduled panel interview.

Application Dates

- **Pick up application form** at the Medical Occupations Office, Room 216 or print from **emras.edu**, *starting on **July 22, 2019***.
 - Please bring VN application form and all necessary supporting documentation to Room 216.
 - Pay the non-refundable application fee (\$20.00) at the EMRAS Registration Office.
 - Please return VN application form and all necessary supporting documentation with your fee receipt to the Medical Occupations office (Room 216) in order to be scheduled for the VN entrance examination.
- **Be advised that this process is subject to unannounced changes.**
- **Deadline to submit application:** **Monday, September 23, 2019**, or until all entrance exam spaces have been filled.

EMRAS Registration Fee is **\$20.00 per quarter + VN Program Fee of \$4,000.00 = \$4,100.00**
